A side note for those not familiar with **Operation Hood**. This group was formed to help the overrun property on Hood Road in Fredericksburg. Also know as "behind the Pizza Hut on Route 1". About 300 cats & kittens were vetted and relocated. Operation Hood has accomplished amazing things!
