Cats who test positive for Feline Immunodeficiency Virus are often euthanized or are considered Unadoptable. In fact, cats who test positive for FIV usually live long, healthy lives and do not infect other household pets!

FIV is mainly passed from cat to cat through deep bite wounds, the kind that usually occur outdoors during aggressive fights and territorial disputes.

A cat CANNOT pass on FIV by living with other cats, sharing water bowls or cleaning each other.

FIV cats do not become ill and die at an early age.

FIV+ do not have a higher incidence of illness and live the same lifespan as non FIV+ cats.

Multiple medical studies show that cats who test positive for FIV live just as long as FIV- negative cats.

"FIV itself does not cause severe clinical signs and FIV Infected cats live many years without any health problems." - Hartman, Veterinary Immunology and Immunopathology, 2011.
